





## Project Overview

The goal of this project is to collect high-quality audio samples of **natural, unscripted conversations** between two or more **native speakers**. These recordings may be used for **research**, to help train **voice-based technologies**, or for similar non-commercial purposes.





## Who Can Sign Up?

### Anyone who:

- Meets the required minimum age (typically 18 years or older)
- Has clear speech in their native language
- Has access to a quiet environment
- Has the proper device to record
- Agrees to the guidelines and consent terms.

*No professional voice or interpreter training is required.*





## Step 1: Register for the Project

Register on the link you receive via email to complete the sign-up process. Once you've signed up, **send the sign-up link to your recording partner** to complete the registration.

Once your registration is complete, you'll receive an email with a form to set up your recording session(s).





## Step 2: Sign up to Record a Session

**Coordinate a time to record** with your partner. Once you're ready, **one person from the pair** should complete the form sent to their email.

*In the form:*

- Include **both participants' email addresses**
- Select your **shared native language**
- Select as **many topics** as you like.





## Step 2: Sign up to Record a Session

*After submitting the form, **both of you will receive individual email links** for each topic selected to begin recording.*

Your recording session is all set! Recordings must be received by 11:59 pm UTC on July 20th, 2025, so don't wait to record.

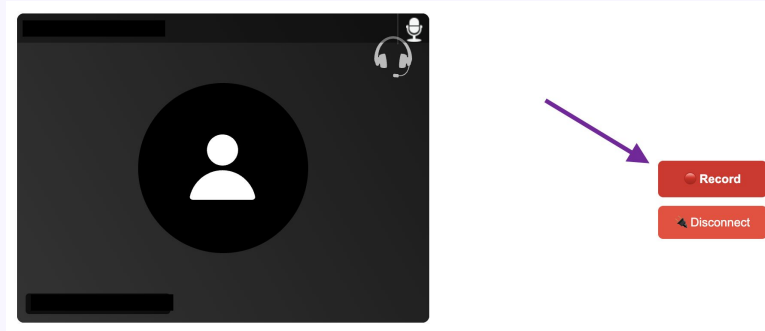
This is your personal recording link, so please keep it safe and do not share it with others. Coordinate directly with your partner to choose a time that works for both of you.



## Step 3: Record Your Conversation

Both participants must click on the **link sent** to access the recording session for your topic.

Once you've both joined, click on record, and start talking.





## Prepare for Success

**Before** pressing record, please ensure that both you and your recording partner have **thoroughly** read the articles available in the [Content Creation Project](#) FAQs.

This will help you fully understand the project requirements, what you can record, how to get paid and much more!

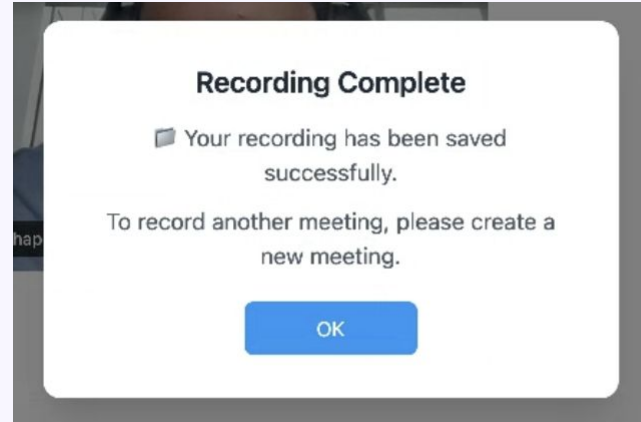
Following this step will **avoid** having your **recordings rejected**.





## Step 4: Stop the Recording

Click **Stop** to end the recording.



*This is your confirmation that your recording is submitted.  
You won't receive anything notification via email.*





## Step 5: Submit Your Conversation

As soon as you click **Stop** on the recording, your conversation is automatically uploaded to Jeenie and you are free to move on to your next conversation.

**Important: If you don't click Stop**, your recording will not be submitted and **you will not be paid**.





# Recording Tips and Tricks

## ✓ DOs:

**Read the [FAQs](#) carefully before you begin** – This ensures you understand the project and avoid mistakes that could lead to rejection.

**Record in a quiet environment** – Minimize background noise for the best audio quality.

**Use your own device** – Each speaker must record from a separate device.

**Use a proper recording headset or quality microphone** – To avoid echo, feedback, or unclear sound.

## ✗ DON'Ts:

**Don't record in the same room as your partner** – Even with separate devices, this causes interference and poor audio quality.

**Don't discuss politics, religion, or use profanity** – These topics are not allowed and will result in disqualified recordings.

**Don't record from public spaces** – such as outdoors, cars, supermarket, stores, etc.

**Don't record with your camera off** – video is essential for our internal quality assurance process.





# Setting Up For Payment

## How Payments Work

- Jeenie sends your funds to **ProZ\*Pay** within the first 10 days of each month **for all accepted recordings** from the previous month.
- Funds are **available** no later than the **25th of that month**.
